I just wanted to touch base to say thank you. My son, Orson (B12 Sky), developed acute anxiety during the 2021 lockdown. He lost his love of everything he had previously enjoyed - including football. His condition had a deleterious effect on the whole family. He did not want to attend the Gothia tournament; he was, frankly, dreading it. He attended because we insisted upon it.

It turned out, he says, to be the best thing he has ever done. It took him a couple of days to get into it, but by Friday, he would gladly have stayed a second week. He loved everything about it - the coaches, the football, the school, Liseberg, the music, the camaraderie, the ceremonies, the football finals - absolutely everything. He was very lucky to have an amazing coaching team. Norbert and Khaled were amazing - on and off the pitch. They set the tone for the week - and as a result, the boys and the parents had a wonderful time. They overcame a devastating start (Vilnius academy were "rather good" to say the least!) to become a team who played for each other and understood each other. I rather think that if the tournament had started mid way through the week, the results might have been even better than they turned out.

It is no exaggeration to say that Orson's week at the Gothia Cup has set him on the road to rediscovering the boy he used to be - both in terms of football and generally.
